- DIMA is a state of the art communications oriented college in South Korea. It's located in Anseong, which is just 40 minutes from beautiful Seoul.

- Required & collateral courses are offered including: Video Field Production, Video/Editing Post-Production, Audio Production, Media Ethics, Photography, PR Writing, International PR, Research Methods, and others. All courses are in English!

- Costs To Attend:
 - CSUF Tuition (12+ credits)
 - \$4200 Room & Board for 1 term
 - \$1000 for Airfare

 - CSUF credit- You register at CSUF and receive credit from CSUF.
 - Financial Aid: Still qualify for financial aid- which may be increased for study abroad.
