Major Advising:

- Entry level COMD major core classes: 241, 242, 307, 344**
- It is recommended to take 4 courses per semester with 2-3 COMD courses along with 1-2 other non-COMD courses in your 1st semester at CSUF.
 - Additional unrestricted elective course units may be needed to obtain the 120 units needed for graduation (e.g., extra GE classes or COMD electives, classes to meet public school credential and/or ASHA certification requirements, classes for a second major, minor or the honors program).
 - If you are a graduating senior, contact the Undergrad advisor, Dr. Kim, to get help with registration for classes you need to take in order to graduate on time.
 - Applying for graduation:** Once you have initiated the grad check process through your student portal, email Dr. Kim (minjungk@fullerton.edu). Then, she can approve electronically. Initiate your grad check as soon as you are eligible to do so.
 - If you have any further question regarding your academic plan and course requirement, you can always contact your assigned advisor. For any questions regarding registration, grad check, and COMD 495 internship course, you can contact Dr. Kim.
 - Courses that may be available in Summer: COMD 241, 344, 350, 461, 404, 476 and 495, and these courses will be offered only when sufficient number of students are enrolled.

Additional Course Requirement (These additional courses are not required for graduation, but for graduate school. Therefore, you can take them at a JC if you will complete a total of 120 units with GE and COMD major requirements.)

For ASHA Certification:

- 1) a stand-alone **statistics** (e.g., MATH 120; SOC1 303 fulfills GE B5)
- 2) Intro level **chemistry** or **physics** (CHEM 100 or PHYS 101)
- 3) **biological science** (e.g., BIOL 101)

For the California public school credential:

- 1) **Psych 361** (Developmental Psychology): a course indicated as CAS 101 (Introduction to Child and Adolescent Development) in your transcript is equivalent to Psych 361.
- 2) **SPED 371** (Exceptional Individual): Some community colleges have a course equivalent to SpEd 371 (e.g. CDEV 205 at Santa Ana college; HUD 205 at Santiago Canyon college). The course title includes "exceptionality" or "children with special needs."
