<p>Admission Decision</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The admission is on a rolling basis 	<p>Late March or early April</p>

<p>Mandatory Orientation Workshop is required to</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Confirm your intent to matriculate CSU-Fullerton ● Generate your study plan <p>At the workshop, you will have a chance to ask any questions regarding the program. You will also have a chance to meet with other postbac or graduate students in the program.</p>	<p>Around late April or mid-May</p>
<p>Accept Admission Offer & Enroll in Classes</p> <p>After attending the orientation workshop, you may expect to receive an official admission letter from the Admissions Office. From there, you may begin to enroll in fall classes.</p>	<p>In a week or two after the orientation workshop</p>
<p>You may choose to begin taking 1 or 2 lower level classes (241, 242, 307, 344) offered in summer through OPEN University. This is only optional, not required.</p> <p>For tuition and campus fee, you will visit the website.</p>
