## ADVISING NOTES

1. The University requires that students have at least 40 units of upper division (UD) coursework (300- & 400-level) across ALL classes.
2. When you have 85 or more units, a cumulative GPA of 1.85 or higher, and have declared a major, you should apply for graduation. Do it online through the Student Center.
3. The University requires you to have 120 units or more to graduate. 51 of these are GE requirements. CTVA is a 36 unit major, with an additional 12 units of coursework from either the CTVA electives or the list of approved collaterals.
4. You must have a minimum 2.0 grade point average (GPA) across all university and major classes to graduate.
5. If you do not pass a prerequisite course with a C or above, then you cannot enroll in the next class. If you do not get a C or above, you can either retake the prerequisite course (to get a C or above) or you can keep your grade, but you cannot pass on to the next class.
6. You must pass any UDW course with a C or above.
7. The \*\* denotes collateral courses that could count toward both GE and collateral electives. See an advisor for specific GE category information as it may have changed for catalog years 2018, 2019 and later.
8. Double Majors or Minors should not need to take collateral courses. Completion of a minor or double major in OTHER departments qualifies.
