_____ **Qualification:** You must have a GPA of 3.0 or above for the last 60 units of college course work by the posted deadline.

_____ You will submit the following materials to **the assigned Offices.**

_____ **A.** *Official* transcripts from all the universities and/or community colleges that you’ve attended, even only enrolled in one class have to be submitted to University Admissions and Records Office:

_____ **B.** Passing CBEST scores in all areas (reading, math, and writing) must be submitted to the Department of Human Communication Studies at the following address:

If you’ve ever taken and passed the test previously, no need to re-take it. It may also be waived if you have taken other basic skills test similar to CBEST, click the Commission on Teacher Credentialing (<http://www.ctc.ca.gov/>) for the guidelines.

However, CBEST cannot be replaced by GRE.

If admitted, you may expect to receive admission notification started in April/May and continued throughout the summer once your application file is completed at Admissions and Records Office, and it is forwarded to the Department for review.
