- 21 units.** Minimum for RTVF minor.
- 40 UD units.** Minimum 40 units total upper division coursework; check Titan Degree Audit <http://www.fullerton.edu/admissions/CurrentStudent/DegreeAudit.asp>.
- "C" requirement.** Minimum 2.0 average in any prerequisite class, and overall university average.
- EWP.** Examination in Writing Proficiency; apply when junior—60 units, <http://www.fullerton.edu/testing/ewp.htm>, University Testing Services, UH-229, 714-

278-3838, testingcenter@fullerton.edu.

5. **Grad check.** (1) Apply for graduation check at Admissions & Records (A&R), LH-114, when senior—90 units; (2) after receiving form in mail, take to RTVF advisor, with student file from office—CP-460-16; (3) return completed form to A&R, LH-114.
